3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

1. To promote, develop, preserve, renovate, maintain, support and manage temples, religious institutions, pilgrimage centres, spiritual centres, gaushalas, dharamshalas, museums, libraries and cultural heritage institutions, to preserve and promote Sanatan values, Indian culture, spirituality, ethical values, scriptures, traditional knowledge, arts, languages and heritage, and to organize religious, cultural, spiritual and awareness programmes for public benefit without any profit motive.

2. To promote, operate and support schools, colleges, educational institutions, digital learning platforms, vocational training centres, research institutes, innovation centres, libraries, coaching centres, certification programmes and skill development initiatives, to promote education, moral values, scientific temperament, entrepreneurship, employment generation, digital literacy and research for the benefit of society, particularly women, children, youth and economically weaker sections.

3. To undertake charitable, humanitarian and welfare

activities for the benefit of the public including education, healthcare, medical relief, nutrition, sanitation, disaster relief, poverty alleviation, women empowerment, child welfare, senior citizen welfare, differently-abled persons, livelihood promotion, legal awareness, financial literacy, rural development, agriculture, animal welfare, environmental protection and other activities of public utility without discrimination on the basis of caste, creed, religion, gender or region.

4. To promote, establish and operate digital platforms, software applications, websites, online educational portals, research databases, communication systems, digital archives, media platforms, publications, OTT platforms, digital broadcasting, community networks and other technological solutions for promoting education, culture, religion, public awareness, social welfare, research, skill development and charitable activities, and to encourage the use of emerging technologies including Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning and other lawful technologies for public benefit.

5. To collaborate with Governments, statutory authorities, educational institutions, corporate bodies, international organizations, trusts, societies, Section 8 companies and other lawful entities for implementing charitable, educational, cultural, environmental, healthcare, research, CSR, FCRA-compliant and public welfare programmes, to receive grants, donations, subscriptions and lawful contributions; and to undertake all activities incidental to achieving the charitable objects of the Company.

(b) *Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

1. To establish, maintain, manage, support or grant aid to schools, colleges, training institutes, skill development centers, libraries, hostels, research institutions, community centers and other educational institutions for the advancement of education and knowledge.
2. To promote social harmony, communal harmony, national integration, and peaceful coexistence among all communities and sections of society.
3. To establish, develop, promote, support, preserve, renovate, maintain, and manage temples, dhaams, ashrams, gaushalas, dharamshalas, spiritual centres, pilgrimage centres, and other religious places of Sanatan Dharma
4. To organize and conduct religious discourses, Satsang, katha, bhajan, kirtan, yajna, havan, pooja, meditation camps, yoga camps, spiritual seminars, conferences, and awareness programmes for the spiritual upliftment of society.
5. To promote, assist in document digitize, catalogue, and preserve the history, architecture, traditions, heritage, rituals, and cultural significance of temples and other religious institutions for future generations.
6. To promote, establish, operate, and manage news portals, digital news networks, online newspapers, magazines, and journalism platforms for awareness.
7. To assist in the implementation and promotion of public welfare schemes and policies of the Central and State Governments and other authorities for the benefit of the

public at large, and to undertake activities incidental or conducive to the attainment of the Company's main objects, without any profit motive.

8. To promote, or connect, unite, and integrate all Hindus, temples, pujaris, pandits, dhaams, ashrams, and religious organizations under one digital ecosystem to strengthen the Sanatan community and to work for the Temple Jodo and Hindu Jodo Abhiyan ? connecting every Hindu to their temples, cultural roots, and community, thereby strengthening the social and spiritual fabric of the nation.

9. To facilitate, promote, and support the appointment, training, welfare, and recognition of pujaris, pandits, and religious leaders, and to create a platform for their digital presence, voting, and community engagement and to work for the welfare, support, and upliftment of saints, sadhus, sages, spiritual leaders, and religious personalities, and to provide them with recognition, resources, and community support.

10. To provide scholarships, fellowships, grants, stipends, educational materials, books, uniforms and other assistance to students, especially those belonging to economically weaker and underprivileged sections of society.

11. To undertake research, documentation, archiving and preservation of traditional, folk, classical and contemporary art forms, cultural practices and performance techniques.

12. To promote vocational education and skill development programs for youth, women and unemployed persons in order to enhance their employability, entrepreneurship and self-reliance.

13. To undertake programs for the welfare, rehabilitation and support of children, women, senior citizens, differently-abled persons and other marginalized or disadvantaged groups.

14. To acquire, purchase, hire, lease, own, maintain, develop, construct or dispose of land, buildings, equipment, facilities, tools, digital infrastructure, computers, labs, and any other assets required for carrying out the Company's objectives.

15. To organize camp programme, or any other type of gathering to clean the streets, roads, railway stations and infrastructure of the country with an aim of clean and green India with the help of public.

16. To undertake activities in relation to Right to information Act (RTI Act) or ask any questions to the government or seek any information, take copies of any government documents, inspect any government documents, inspect any government works, take samples of materials of any government work or seek any other information or take copies of any documents which are covered under the RTI Act, 2005 (including any modification, amendments or re-enactment thereof) if any, for the benefit of members of society.

17. To raise, obtain, receive, accept or manage donations, grants, subscriptions, CSR funds, endowments, aids, contributions or financial assistance from individuals, institutions, companies, banks, governments or other bodies to promote the Company's objects.

18. To hold, sponsor, organise, support or collaborate conferences, seminars, symposia, meetings, training

programmes, demonstrations, mass mobilization campaigns, popular lectures, cultural programmes, etc, to promote above mentioned objectives.

19. To enter into contractual agreement, cooperation, or collaboration with governmental, non-governmental and private organisations, trust, society or other non-profit organisations for carrying out objectives or to collaborate with other similar companies under Section 8, trust, society or other non-profit organisations for enhancing the common objects.

20. To do all such other acts, deeds, matters and things as may be necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects, provided that the same are not inconsistent with the provisions of Section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013.

Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an object of the company, would make it a trade union.

5 (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when-so-ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company
